2 Brooding and Rearing. Brooding and rearing should be carried out in separate facilities. Once chicks have hatched they must be properly brooded. In a research setting, tiered battery brooders are convenient for brooding birds for about 4 weeks, depending upon the size of the birds. Soon after hatching, all chicks must be individually identified either through wing bands or neck tags.

Brooders have a source of heat to replace the heat that the young would have from their mother. In the brooder they are protected from animals and the weather. A simple brooder is made from a heavy box or basket and a hurricane lamp (kerosene lamp) as the source of heat. A 1 metre square box will make a brooder for 25 baby birds.
