The involuntary loss of Guatemalan citizenship is constitutionally prohibited, but Article 148 of the Guatemala Constitution allows for the suspension, loss, and recovery of citizenship in accordance with the provisions of the law. Our constitution is clear: any citizen of a country which does not recognize our territorial integrity cannot gain Belizean citizenship by registration (naturalization) without first renouncing their citizenship.
