Request a verification of your license, certificate or exam

The Massachusetts Board of Registration of Professional Engineers and Professional Land Surveyors has engaged Professional Credential Services (PCS) for application processing, examination administration and score reporting of the engineering and land surveying examinations. PCS coordinates the examinations.

Professional Credential Services Engineering & Surveying

The PE 16-hour Structural exam tests for a minimum level of competency in structural engineering. This exam uses separate vertical and lateral components to test your ability to safely design buildings or bridges, especially in areas of high seismicity and high wind.

As a general rule, a professional engineer who has (1) an approved four-year engineering degree, (2) four years of qualifying engineering experience, and who successfully completes (3) the eight-hour Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) Examination and (4) the eight-hour Principles and Practice of Engineering (PE) Examination will be able to get licensed in virtually every state without difficulty.

All applicants are required to take and to pass the eight-hour NCEES Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) exam and the NCEES Principles and Practices of Engineering (PE) exam except twenty year applicants applying under classification (e), who are not required to take the FE exam.
